Know final -e and common vowel team conventions for representing long vowel sounds


Read the words with "I" blends: fl, cl, pl, sl

Decode two-syllable words following basic patterns
by breaking the words into syllables

Identify the beginning, middle, and end of a story Retell stories, including key details, and demonstrate understanding of their central message or lesson
