ENGLISH

Topic

Long and Short Vowels

Skill

Distinguish long from short vowel sounds in spoken single-syllable words
Know final -e and common vowel team conventions for representing long vowel sounds

Blends and Digraphs

Read the words with "l" blends: fl, cl, pl, sl
Read the words with "r" blends: dr, tr, fr
Recognize the sound of each consonant blend
Complete the words with the correct consonant blends
Know the spelling-sound correspondences for common consonant digraphs: wh, ch, th, sh

Sight Words

Read and spell common sight words
Decode two-syllable words following basic patterns by breaking the words into syllables

Reading Fiction

Identify the beginning, middle, and end of a story
Retell stories, including key details, and demonstrate understanding of their central message or lesson

Reading Informational Texts

Use illustrations to aid comprehension
Identify character's feelings
Identify first and third person point of view

Read a biography
Read a historical text
Read a scientific text
Summarize and answer questions about key details in a text
Identify text features

Across Genres

Differentiate between realistic fiction and fantasy stories
Read poems and identify words that rhyme
Identify folktales
Identify elements of different genres

Parts of Speech

Identify whether a noun is a person, animal, place or thing
Identify nouns and verbs in sentences
Use verbs to convey a sense of past and present

Punctuation and Capitalization

Capitalize words in sentences
Capitalize the names of people
Capitalize days and months
Use end punctuation for sentences



MATH

Topic

Numbers and Counting

Skill

Count to 100 and beyond
Use number lines to count
Learn cardinal and ordinal numbers
Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s

Place Value

Understand that the two digits of a two-digit number represent amounts of tens and ones
Trade ones for tens
Identify groups of tens
Compare two-digit numbers with and without picture support

Addition and Subtraction

Add up to 50
Apply properties of addition (commutative, associative, and identity)
Subtract up to 50
Determine the unknown whole number in an addition or subtraction equation relating three whole numbers

Strategies for Addition and Subtraction

Use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract
Understand doubles facts, turnaround facts, and fact families
Add and subtract with base 10 blocks
Use picture support to solve addition and subtraction word problems

Identify coins
Count money
Solve money word problems

Telling Time

Tell time by the hour
Tell time by the half hour
Match digital to analog clocks
Understand a.m. and p.m.

Measurement

Measure length and height
Identify and compare different measurements of weight
Measure volume - cups, pints, quarts, gallons
Measure using non-standard units of measurement
Solve length and size word problems
Put objects in order

Geometry

Draw shapes
Distinguish between 2D and 3D shapes
Sort shapes
Understand sides and vertices
Identify how to split shapes into parts and name the shares

Explore the concept of government
Identify the functions of the three branches of government
Differentiate between local and national government
Explain the rights and responsibilities of citizens

American History

Learn about important people and events from the past
Identify how society has changed over time
Learn about colonial times

Identify, compare, and contrast common places
Learn about rural and urban communities

Community Helpers

Learn about doctors (general practice, dentists, and vets)
Understand the roles of city workers

Explore how resources affect members of society
