

### Importance of PHSE Education for Young Learners Development

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#### What Is PSHE Education?

PSHE education is a school subject which focuses on teaching children the skills they will need for their lives, both now and in the future. From helping students understand how they can take steps to improve their wellbeing, to exploring what makes a healthy relationship, to looking at way substances such as alcohol and drugs can impact their lives – PSHE plays a crucial role in helping children learn and grow holistically, in addition to the traditional academic subjects they undertake at school.

Young learners' personal, social, health and economic education plays a vital role as it provides them with a practical toolkit to support their relationship with themselves, others and money. They can learn to work as a team, communicate effectively, and be resilient human beings that ultimately will be able to weather the challenges they will encounter within their daily lives, as well as within society as a whole.

# How Schools Can Ensure Effective Practice In PSHE Education

According to a study by the UK's Department for Education, PSHE education can improve the physical and psychosocial wellbeing of pupils who receive it.

The study recommends teachers leading PSHE classes in a school setting to use curricula that engage pupils through a 'whole-school' approach and ensure that the culture of the PSHE education influences all the elements of day-to-day school life, placing children's and staff's wellbeing at the fore.

A beneficial PHSE curriculum should be inclusive of difference across cultures, ethnicity, disability, faith, age, sexual orientation and gender identity. It should also begin at an early age to make sure children at all levels of maturity are able to meet their developmental milestones.

Clear lesson objectives that encourage teamwork is a must, according to the UK DoE's guidance, as is the involvement of a school's wider community, such as agencies, parents, governors and members of the wider community, to ensure an integrated PSHE scheme of study.

## Education for Health and Wellbeing - Global Scope

Studies from UNESCO show that high-quality health and wellbeing education is crucial to help youngsters understand why they need to be healthy and how to take care of oneself; it is also a fundamental way to avoid sickness and disease.

The United Nations organisation has pledged to work on the implementation of ongoing health and wellbeing education to end AIDS and promote better health worldwide. UNESCO states are "...committed to strengthening the links between education and health, reflecting growing international recognition that a more comprehensive approach to school health and coordinated action across sectors is needed."

The organisation references statistics from their Global Education Monitoring Report, that show how influential beneficial health and wellness education is worldwide in improving nutrition and vaccination rates, lessening infantile deaths, maternal mortality and reducing HIV rates.

In their study called Making every school a health-promoting school, UNESCO say that no education system is successful unless it promotes the health and wellbeing of all those within it, specifically in the time of the Covid-19 pandemic. They speak of the way in which the pandemic has made the health and wellbeing of school populations more strained, and as a result emphasise the continued importance of PSHE education as a way to counteract this strain.


